IX/1 Nancy Neala Houck told:

Samuel David Meason and Clara E. Mirus (Meason came to Texas from Illinois in 1875. My grandfather, Jesse told my mother that they came down the Mississippi River on a brage. They settled in Collin County, Texas which is just north of Dallas. (In fact I live in Collin County now in about the same area they settled in when they ware Texas pioneers). They lived in Collin County until 1890, when they moved farther nort to Denton County, Texas where they farmed 4 miles east of Lewisville, Texas. In 1895, they moved to Foard County Texas, which is what in xalled the „panhandle“ and took them 12 says to make the trip in a covered wagon. They moved to Quanah, Texas in 1899. (Quanah is named for the last great chief of the Comanche Indians.- Qunah Parker). In March Of 1918, they went to live with their daughter Eva Meason McLarty until their deaths. -- My great grandparents must have also come to Texas about they same time as D. And Clara because they died in 1881 and are buried and old pioneer cemetery in the middle of north Dallas. Their names were George Mansfield Meason and Martha T. Reed Meason. My grandfather Jesse told the story of why they left Texas to go to Oklahoma somewhere around 1908. They were farming some land on the river bottom of the Trinity River around Lewisville, Texas. During the rainy season the river floodes frequently and my grandfather may have had malaria (tey didn't know what it was back them). One time it flooded so much that they had to climb up in a lage tree and cling to they decided to go to Oklahoma where they had opened up the western part of the state to farming. They traveled by covered wagon crossing the Red River, which the dividing line between Texas and Oklahoma at a place called „Doan's Crossing“ I have been to that spot and the old cabin where Mr. Doan lived and ran the ferry is still there. (June 15 in 2000 Hellmut Mirus)
